Travelling to the Anne Rowling Clinic

The Anne Rowling Clinic is located on the site of the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh at Little France, in the south east part of Edinburgh, about four miles from the city centre.

By Bus

The Little France site is well served by public transport and there are regular buses from the city centre. The journey takes about 30 minutes. By Rail

By Car

The Little France site is situated on the A7, about four miles south-east of the city centre. It is also very accessible from the A720 Edinburgh city bypass. The postcode for sat-navs is EH16 4SB.



The Anne Rowling Clinic does not have a car park. There is a turning circle in front of the main hospital entrance for drop-off, and pay parking is available adjacent to the Clinic. Charges are similar to other commercial car parks. A very limited number of disabled parking spaces is available (see map below). Unfortunately a space cannot be guaranteed even for blue badge holders. We advise travelling by public transport if possible.
